DISTRICT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT - Clir. R. Foss -

- SHDC are looking at the sites which are going towards the 5 year land supply. There are no sites in Charleton.
- The suggestion was made that the community be consulted as to whether they might consider having a proactive approach to housing development which they could lodge with SHDC.
- Local Authority Controlled Company is still being progressed.

COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT - Cllr. J. Brazil -

- There is a debate about the CCG's regulation of the NHS. In short, they are looking to get rid of the community beds in Devon and hope to treat people in their homes with outreach workers.
- Dartmouth Community Hospital is to close and the minor injuries unit will be at Totnes.
- South Hams Hospital is set to continue.
- Patients at Chillington Health Centre are sent to Torbay and will then use Totnes Hospital for any further treatment.

POLICE REPORT – PC J. Gerrard by email

- There have been no reported crimes since the last report.
- We have, in consultation with the school, been patrolling at school drop off and pick up points. We are pleased to report that parking on the zig zags has significantly dropped with only one ticket being issued. We will continue to monitor this for the safety of our children.

- Discussion took place on the boxes to purchase to take the defibrillators.
- Training for the use of the defibrillators will be advertised on onecharleton when it has been organized.
- Flooding on Copse Corner was reported and DC responded quickly to clear the gulley of leaves.
